

UNDERSTANDING THE CPD CHANNELS

Channel 0: Foundation Phase

This channel is designed specifically for CIBA members. For example, a farmer running their own books or a lawyer managing the finances of their firm. 

Being a licensed SARS Tax Practitioner means that an individual is registered with the South African Revenue Service (SARS) and authorised to provide tax-related services to the public. This requires the practitioner to be a member of a Recognised Controlling Body (RCB) which ensures that they meet the necessary qualifications, ethical standards, and compliance requirements.

CIBA is a Recognised Controlling Body (RCB) and license Tax Practitioners on SARS behalf. This grants practitioners credibility and the legal right to represent clients in dealing with SARS.

In addition CIBA oversees and supports Tax Practitioners, with valuable resources, Regulator Representation, Technical Support, enabling Tax Practitioners to offer quality and compliant tax services to their clients. Members can apply from within their membership profile or read more here.


